

Outreach Minister

This position will be part of a ministry team of equals working with the Body-Life/Involvement Minister. Other positions including interns will be added as the Lord leads.

Key task:

We are seeking a man or husband-wife team with a demonstrated passion and lifestyle of bringing the lost to Christ and for equipping others to bring the Gospel to the community.

This position will have these duties:

- Study the Bible with non-Christians bringing them to a decision about following Christ.
- Develop a strategic plan to equip and involve current and new members with outreach techniques and tools.
- Lead the effort to help ministry groups and Common Bond groups include an outreach focus.
- Coordinate follow-up with visitors together with the evangelism ministry group.
- Develop and implement a plan for area group Bible studies.
- With the Seminar Committee, participate in the coordination and planning of the Mid-Atlantic Evangelism Seminar.
- Develop and implement community outreach programs and events to bring Jesus to the community.
- Preach as needed. Pulpit duties will be shared with the Body-Life/Involvement Minister.

The successful candidate will meet most of these expectations:

- Mature in the faith, a man of prayer and faith in Jesus Christ, having a good reputation in the community. If married, his wife is also a co-partner in the ministry, mature in the faith, a woman of prayer and faith in Jesus Christ, having a good reputation in the community.
- Five years experience in outreach focused activities with demonstrated effectiveness converting the lost and involving congregation members in the outreach of the church.
- Demonstrated ability to motivate and work with diverse groups.
- Demonstrated ability to develop Bible based teaching materials and lesson series.
- Positive attitude and ability to look at challenges as opportunities.
- Ability to prioritize and execute tasks with minimal supervision based on goals.
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills, written and oral. Works well with people. Effective with delegation of tasks.
- Handles conflict and criticism scripturally.
- Computer literate including proficiency with MS Office applications. Expected to work with Technology team for effective presentations.
